A Little Sunshine Recipe for those Cold Days

Scalloped Potatoes and Ham
Slow-Cooker Recipe

2-3 peeled, sliced & divided

2 cups shredded cheddar cheese divided

12 oz. pkg. or 1 lb. of cooked ham, cubed & divided

10 oz. can of celery soup or mushroom soup

1 small onion, chopped & divided

Spray inside of crock pot with non-stick cooking spray

Layer half of each: potatoes, ham, onion and cheese

Repeat twice

Spread soup, mixed with 1/2 cup water over the top.

Cover and let cook on low for 6-8 hours until tender.

Makes 4-6 servings.
