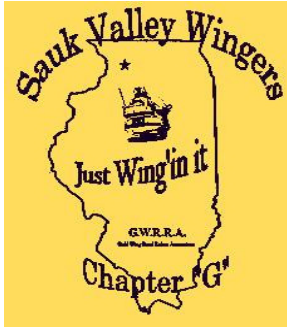

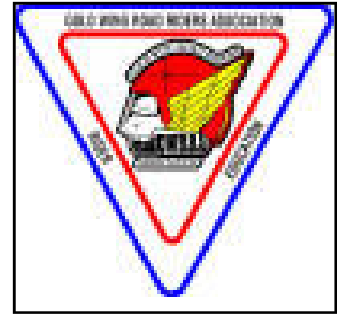

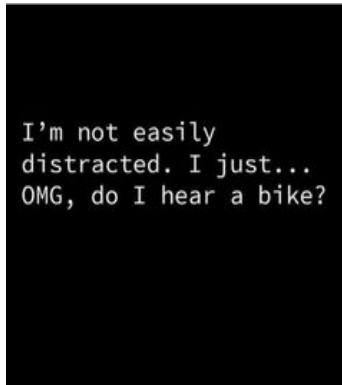
It's another month and we still can't ride together as a chapter. But we can ride as friends, you know what I mean.

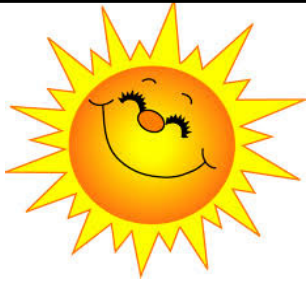
