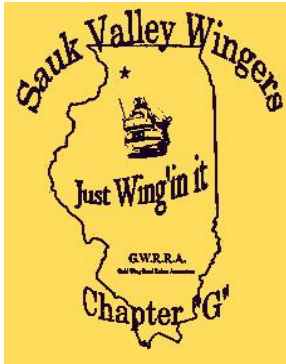

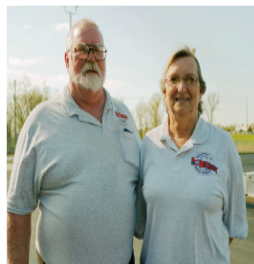

In Vandalia we are having a Trike Trailing course on April 21, and a Bike Trailing course on April 22.

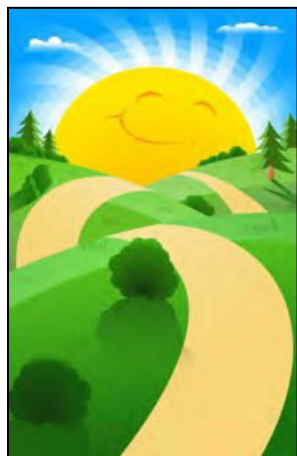
In Sterling we are having a Bike ARC course on May 5 and a Trike TRC course on May 6.

The forms are on the District website under the Safety banner, then to the drop-down box to Rider Educators, then to Rider courses. Scroll down to the course you want to take and print it out and send it to me. You can scan the form and send it or use snail mail. Just be sure you sign the form and send the money with it.

Those in the Levels program, for the rider this is part of Levels 2,3 and Masters. For the co-rider, this can replace the co-rider seminar as long as the co-rider completes the classroom and range exercises, not just one or the other but both.

Continue to ride safely and if there are any questions about any portion of the Rider Education programs. courses, seminars, Levels, or patches and bars, contact me. My phone or e-mail is on usually till 10:30pm.

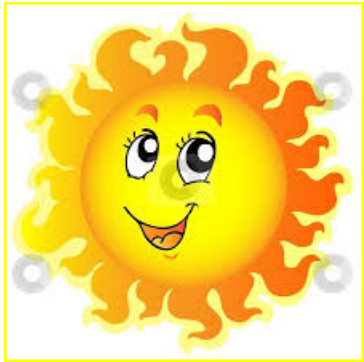

Miles are accumulative - visit once or all seven months.

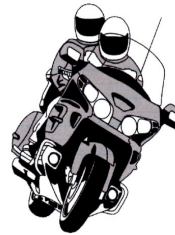
Highest mileage wins - tie will be broken by a drawing.

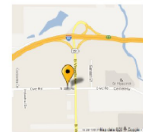
