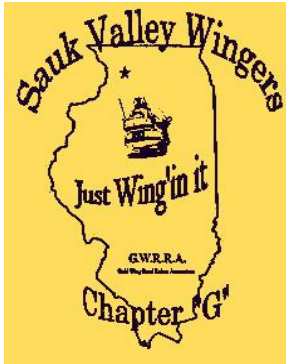

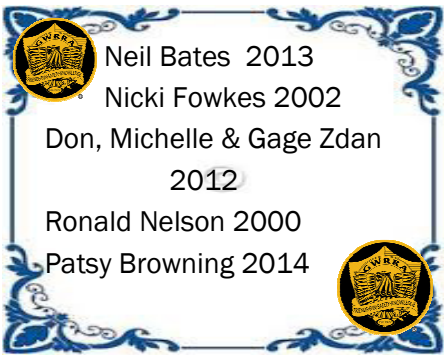
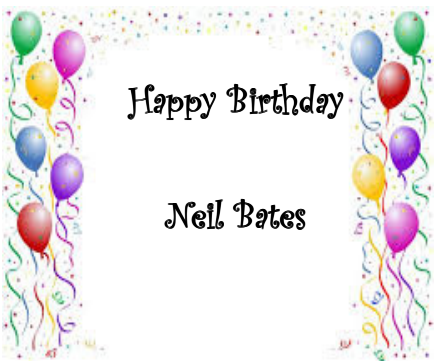

Miles are accumulative - visit once or all seven months.

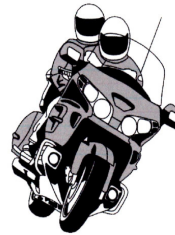

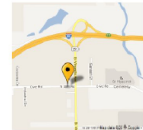
